Abstracts

The list of topics of interest is provided below. These are only examples of topics and papers on other topics, relevant to the systematic creative and innovative design, will be also considered.

- Global knowledge management in inventive design
- Innovation in the area of services using robust and systematic tools
- TRIZ-based or inspired theories, methodologies, methods
- Patent Mining, knowledge acquisition and harvesting and knowledge representation
- Professional/industrial case studies in which TRIZ has played a significant role
- Advanced innovative, inventive & creative design processes based on systematic methods
- IT for innovation engineering /Computer Aided Innovation (CAI)
- Knowledge-Based Systematic Innovation Customized Services
- Product lifecycle management, laws of technical system evolution
- Methodological support to creative and inventive design
- Inventiveness, creativity, innovation measurements (or assessment) based on systematic methods.

REVIEW:

There will be a formal review of all abstracts.

The abstracts need to be submitted through the TFC2016 conference management system available at http://www.tfc2016.com/. An abstract should clearly present major contributions of a given paper and its novelty.

Selection of the papers will be made using the following criteria:

- 1. Significance
- 2. Novelty
- 3. Quality
- 4. Relevance

Since papers will be presented within two separate tracks, authors should clearly indicate the nature of their papers: "Research Track" or "Industrial Track."

All scientific reviewed papers will be published in Procedia CIRP indexed in the EI Compendex and Scopus databases.



Practitioner's papers will be published in the proceedings of the TRIZ Future Conference 2016 and in the ETRIA Journal.

AUTHOR GUIDELINES

Two types of papers are invited:

- **«Scientific papers»** related to the TRIZ theory and methodological developments
- **«Practitioners papers»** related to the application of innovation methodologies

Two kinds of papers are encouraged:

« Short papers »

Approximately 800 words, about two pages. 15-minutes presentation (including Q&A).

« Long papers »

Approximately 2,400 words, about four to six pages. 30-minutes presentation including Q&A).
